WIN 30 1933

Please order the following equipment for the
Bureau of Investigation:

- 21 Automatic Shot Guns, 12 Gauge, either Remington or Winchester, Cylinder Bore, 20" Barrel, to be fired with Buckshot Shell.
- 21 Springfield Sporter Rifles, U.R.A. type, .30-'06 calibre, with 20 inch barrel.

It is understood that the Springfield Sporter Rifle can be ordered direct from the War Department, through the Commanding Officer, Ordnance Department, United States Army, Washington, D. C. The order should specify that "Settlement will be made in accordance with Section 601, Act of June 30, 1932."

The Bureau desires that one of each of the above guns be sent to each of the Bureau field offices with the exception of Honolulu.

It is imperative that this order be placed today, in order that payment for this equipment may be made from the appropriation for the Fiscal Year 1933.
