MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR.

I have arranged to borrow from Mr. Young of the Federal Laboratories in Pittsburgh, four or five machine guns, two shields and one gas gun, with appropriate ammunition. Mr. Tamm will have an Agent or two Agents, if necessary, take this equipment to Indianapolis. The Agent will telephone Mr. Connelley from the station at the Spink-Arms Hotel and will receive instructions from him as to where this equipment is to be delivered.

Orders are being placed today for an additional shotgun and an additional Sporter rifle for each field office and for 30 machine guns - 1 or 2 offices receiving more than one such gun. I have arranged with Mr. Bodholdt to send appropriate telegrams today requesting immediate express delivery of these additional equipment to all field offices.

Mr. Connelley advised that the equipment which is being sent from Pittsburgh will be sufficient for his needs.
